Federal Information and News Dispatch offers the following content:

Statistics

- Washington Daybook: 150 stories per weekday
- FedBizOps: 500 stories per weekday
- Federal Register: 130-150 stories per weekday
- SEC Daily News Digest: 9-10 stories per weekday
- White House Press Releases, Facts Sheets, and Briefings: 150-170 stories per weekday [daily volume varies]
- Facts Sheets: 600 stories per month
- Government Periodicals: 500 stories per weekday
- Dept. of Defense Info: 50-100 stories per weekday

- **The Washington Daybook:** A daily wire service providing detailed schedules for U.S. government events including: key economic indicator releases, congressional hearings, federal agency meetings, policy meetings, press conferences, lectures and other events. The Washington Daybook also provides schedules of top government officials and key private-sector events.
- **FedBizOps:** The complete-text equivalent of the print publication that is used every weekday to announce products and services wanted or offered by the U.S. government.
- **The Federal Register:** A daily publication of the U.S. government that serves as the medium for notifying the public of official agency actions. The Federal Register provides a uniform system for making available to the public regulations and legal notices issued by Federal agencies and the President. The documents are grouped and published in the following categories:
Presidential documents, rules and regulations, proposed rules, notices and Sunshine Act meetings. Corrections, Table of Contents, and Unified Agenda records are available online.

In addition, **Federal Information and News Dispatch** offers a bundled content set called “**Federal Government Information**,” which includes the following:

- **SEC Daily News Digest:** Information on recent Commission actions, including enforcement proceedings, rule filings, policy statements and upcoming Commission meetings.
- **White House Press Releases, Fact Sheets and Briefings:** The White House Press releases many documents to the public, including transcripts of the President’s speeches and press conferences, press briefings, policy statements, fact sheets and announcements of nominations. Documents cover many topics including the economy, foreign policy, health care and education.

U.S. Department of State Information:

- **The Washington File:** Provides U.S. government official texts, policy statements and interpretive materials, features and byline articles prepared daily by the U.S. Department of State.
- **Travel Warnings and Advisories:** Based on all relevant information, the State Department issues travel warnings to recommend that Americans avoid travel to a certain country. Countries where avoidance of travel is recommended will

have Travel Warnings as well as Consular Information Sheets.

- **Facts Sheets:** Concise summaries (1-2 pages) of current United States policy on foreign affairs issues. They are updated regularly. When posted, State Department content delivery schedule varies.
- **Government Periodicals:** A wide variety of information, including newsletters, magazines, journals, press releases and other documents from various agencies of the US Federal Government.
- **U.S. Department of Defense Information:** Includes press releases, news articles and other documents from the Department of Defense and military organizations.
- **Department of Homeland Security Documents:** Distributes press releases and documents from DHS and sub agencies.

The **Washington Daybook**, **FedBizOpps**, and the **Federal Register** are also available as separate **Full Feed** offerings.
